Notice of Cancellation of Agency Agreement with NXP Semiconductors

Marubun Corporation (the Company) hereby announces that it has agreed to cancel an agency agreement concluded with NXP Semiconductors N.V. (NXP). Details are as follows.

1. Reason for cancellation of the agency agreement

Policies for sales agency programs were changed due to reorganization carried out between Freescale Semiconductor, Inc. (FS) and NXP, with whom the Company had concluded agency agreements, respectively. The reorganization has led to an agreement for cancellation of the agreement.

2. Schedule for cancellation of the agency agreement

Cancellation date of the agency agreement: March 1, 2017 (plan)

3. Impacts on financial results for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2017

The Company's sales of NXP's products (including FS's products) were approximately 12.0 billion yen (proportion to consolidated sales: 4.3%) for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2016 on a consolidated basis. Impacts on financial results for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2017 are immaterial because transactions will continue until the cancellation takes effect. For forecasts of consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2017, please refer to the "Notice of Revision to Forecasts of Financial Results" disclosed separately today (October 25, 2016).

4. Future outlook

In the mid-term management plan being implemented by the Company, it is working on expanding base businesses, an early commercialization of a new family of products, and a full-scale cultivation of growth markets such as businesses related to automobiles or industrial equipment, as well as the facilitation of global development through a joint operation with Arrow Electronics. By accelerating these initiatives, the Company will seek to minimize the relevant impacts and improve financial results.
